

Transportation to 9NEWS Parade of Lights!

The 2023 9NEWS Parade of Lights are fast approaching and while driving to the event is an option, here are a list of alternative transportation modes to consider that could save you a few bucks at the pump and a headache circling downtown for a parking space.

RTD:

- Rail - With stops at Union Station and Theater District/Convention Center Station, rail brings you close to where the action is. To plan your rail trip, visit the [RTD Trip Planner](#) site.

- Bus - Many of the metro's buses travel through downtown and have stops that will take you close to Civic Center Park and the event route. To plan your bus trip, visit the [RTD Trip Planner](#) site.

- *Please note: RTD services will be impacted due to road closures caused by the Jingle Jog and Parade of Lights. Please ensure that you use the RTD Trip Planner website for the most up to date information on RTD schedules and detours.*

Bicycle:

Throw on your helmet and ride along one of [Denver's many bikeways](#) to get downtown! Hundreds of u-racks are dispersed downtown, and racks located at Denver Public Library, the McNichols Building, and the Wellington Webb Building help get you right to the entrance of Civic Center Park!

Scooter and Bike Share:

Don't own a bike or scooter? Not a problem! Download the Lyft or Lime app and take an e-bike or scooter downtown. Just remember to park responsibly and in places that do not obstruct pedestrian ways, vehicular traffic, or the parade route.
